



Genesis Behavioral Health (GBH) is a private, non-profit organization designated by the State of New Hampshire as the community mental health center serving Belknap and southern Grafton Counties. Founded in 1966, GBH provides comprehensive, integrated mental health treatment for people living with - and recovering from - mental illness and/or emotional distress. In Fiscal Year 2016, GBH's 180 employees served 3,976 children, adults and families and provided nearly a quarter of a million dollars of charity care.

Our Mission & Our Vision

Genesis Behavioral Health's mission is to provide integrated mental and physical health care for people with mental illness while creating wellness and understanding in our community. Our vision is to be the community leader providing quality, accessible and integrated mental and physical health services, delivered with dedication and compassion.

Organizational Overview

GBH provides 24/7 Emergency Services; individual, group and family therapy; mobile crisis teams in the event a tragic event occurs that impacts a community at large, psychiatry; nursing; community support programs for people with severe and persistent mental illness; care management; community-based supports; housing; supported employment; substance use disorder treatment; and specialty services and evidence-based practices for children and their families, including trauma-focused therapy, art therapy and play therapy. Child Impact seminars are offered in Laconia and Plymouth for divorcing families.

GBH collaborates with many other organizations in the region to improve access to care and meet the mental health needs of the community. Clinicians are on-site at several primary care offices, area school districts, nursing homes, Plymouth State University, and Lakes Region Community College. GBH works closely with the judicial system to provide treatment and support for those at risk of incarceration due to their illness. GBH is a key partner in the Laconia School District's "Safe Schools" grant. The agency works closely with LRGHealthcare and Speare Memorial Hospital to provide medical staff, training, and support for programs such as the provision of Emergency Services at three hospitals, the Designated Receiving Facility in Franklin, the Senior Psychiatric Unit in Laconia, and telehealth to rural areas. GBH was one of only sixty recipients nationwide to receive a \$1.6 million four-year Primary and Behavioral Health Care Integration Grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration in 2015. This grant will allow GBH patients to have integrated mental and physical health care at the community mental health center, provided through partnerships with the two area Federally Qualified Health Centers (HealthFirst Family Care Center and Mid-State Health Center).
